

Download Sublime NetYCE syntax

For those who spent a lot of time in templates and scenarios a more advanced editor might be useful. Because of this a syntax highlighter has been created for Sublime Text 3. It highlights the possibilities in templates and well as scenarios and there specific commands.

An example of a template and scenario is shown below:

You can use packagecontrol.io to install the syntax highlighter for NetYCE and it will keep it up to date.

Alternatively, you can download from [this repository](#) and place the syntax file in the Packages/User folder and will it be loaded automatically.

- Windows location: Users/<user>/appdata/roaming/sublime text 3/packages/user
- Linux location: /home/<user>/.config/sublime-text-3/Packages/User
- Mac location: /Users/<user>/Library/Application Support/Sublime Text 3/Packages/User
